 - All residents with scheduled inspections will receive a phone call confirming the inspection and inquiring if anyone in the household has traveled overseas in the past 14 days or if anyone has been sick in the past few weeks. If there is any potential risk to our inspectors, the appointment will be rescheduled. Additionally, our inspectors have been advised to practice social distancing (6ft away) while performing all inspections. Please be respectful of this. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Building Department.
 - The Fire Safety Department has suspended business inspections and smoke alarm certification inspections at this time. There is an affidavit for smoke alarm inspections available so that home closings can continue.

Due to the evolving situation involving COVID-19, the Hillsborough Bureau of Fire Safety is temporarily suspending all CSACMAPFEC inspections and modifying the procedure for obtaining a Certificate of Smoke Alarm, Carbon Monoxide Alarm and Portable Fire Extinguisher Compliance (CSACMAPFEC) required under N.J.A.C 5:70-2.3(a). We are taking these protective measures to help ensure the safety of the residents and staff of Hillsborough Township. We are providing the sellers of 1 and 2-Family dwellings with two options.

Option #1- During this period, the sellers of 1 and 2 family dwellings may postpone their closing until such time that we resume the CSCMAPFEC inspections. Please note that we cannot provide a date when we will resume these inspections; or

Option #2- The seller will submit a CSACMAPFEC application and fee to Fire Safety and the Sellers, Buyers and their attorneys will complete the below affidavit. Under Option # 2, the Buyer will be assuming the responsibility to obtain the CSACMAPFEC at a later date after the closing. Fire Safety will review and approve the affidavit, email the "approved affidavit" to the parties and allow the closing to take place. If the seller and buyer agree to this procedure, we recommend that funds be held in escrow to cover any corrections that the buyer may be required to do, to obtain the CSACMAPFEC.

 - The Borough will be erring on the side of caution and the inspectors will be using discretion when entering dwellings and interacting with individuals. Only essential contractors, homeowners, or authorized representatives necessary for the completion of any inspection shall be on site during such inspection in an effort to limit unnecessary contact.
 - Residential Smoke, Carbon Monoxide and Fire Extinguisher inspections for resale and rental dwellings for real estate closings scheduled on or after April 2 will not be scheduled until at least March 30. Any Residential Smoke, Carbon Monoxide, and Fire Extinguisher inspections for resale and rental of residential dwellings for Closings scheduled before April 2 will occur, however; only one realtor, homeowner, or authorized representative shall be on site during such inspection in an effort to limit unnecessary contact.
 - Rental Compliance Inspections that have been scheduled will be rescheduled for after April 2.
